It is our pleasure to invite you to the Urban\_Wins kick-off conference taking place in Cremona (Italy) on 27<sup>th</sup> September.

The Urban\_Wins team believes that waste does not exist: we see waste as a resource. By having a better understanding of how cities 'eat' resources and generate waste, we will be able to move towards more sustainable consumption and production patterns, and promote a circular economy. This will lead us to an improvement in the quality of life in our cities.

Waste prevention can happen as a result of collectively built solutions and actions: connect with the Urban\_Wins community, join the conference and start acting.
